

## HSM Quality Screens for PDN

P1. Apparently did not appropriately assess and/or act on changes in clinical, mental, or other status.	This screen applies when there is a failure to recognize clinical changes in the patient's condition or if the clinical change is noted and not acted on.
P2. Suspected abuse and/or neglect not appropriately reported.	This screen applies when suspected abuse and /or neglect is identified and not promptly reported appropriately.
P3. Adequate assessment of physical environment and capability of caregiver to provide care in the home.	If there is an indication that the physical environment and/or the capability of the caregiver are in question or not appropriate, this indicator is failed.
P4. Adequacy of the Private Duty Nursing Agency to provide appropriate personnel (LPN or RN) and the ability to staff for the certified hours.	This screen is used for the lack of sufficient staff to cover the certified hours; or lack of credentialed staff for provision of certified hours.
P5. Apparently the plan of care was not followed exactly or no documentation was provided for any deviations from the plan of care.	This screen applies if the plan of care has not been followed or there is no documentation to explain any deviation from the plan, this indicator is failed.
P6. The timely signed plan of care (care plan) reflects measurable goals specific to the areas of care needed by the patient and/or submission of the plan of care in a timely manner.	If the plan of care does not have measurable goals to be achieved or the plan of care is not complete and submitted timely, this indicator is failed.
P7. The Private Duty Nursing Agency will provide the appropriate resources to carry out the established treatment plan.	This screen is used if there is no equipment available to carry out treatment plan, malfunctioning equipment, or no back up equipment.
